Family Lives On Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization headquartered within Eagleview Corporate Center in Exton, PA. Our mission is to support the lifelong emotional well-being of children whose mother or father has died.

The Tradition Program supports grieving children like Nora, Maggie, and Lucy whose dad Ray died in 2009. When we asked them about Traditions they shared with their Dad, Nora mentioned that they loved going to White Sox games together where they would eat Sour Patch Kids. Maggie added that she and her Dad loved watching the movie "*The Incredibles*" together.

Our volunteers sprang into action and shipped Paul Konerko jerseys (Dad's favorite player), White Sox tickets, Sour Patch Kids and Incredibles masks. Decked in jerseys and masks, the girls watched "The Incredibles" on the way to the stadium.
